Checklist of Requirements:

- Original Death Certificate or Report of Death, 3 Certified true copies
- Proof of Identity of the Deceased (if non-Filipino): Four (4) certified true copies of the Australian passport; or

Proof of Filipino citizenship of the deceased, (if applicable): Four (4) certified true copies of the deceased's Philippine passport; Australian Permanent Resident Card or Work Permit, or Dual Citizens documents (Identification Certificate and Approval Order).
- Information on the transport details on how the urn will be transported (e. g. flight details)
- Letter of Authority from next of kin who is authorizing the shipment of the remains with proof of identity and relationship to deceased (birth certificate or marriage contract)
- Valid Passport/Valid ID of applicant

Note: In addition to the above-mentioned requirements, other documents might be required when deemed necessary by the Consular Officer of the Consulate General.
